POLICIES FOR STUDENT GROUPS

Gettysburg, our county's common ground, is also hallowed ground. With this in mind, please respect our past, present and future heritage by observing the following. **(Please Note: We reserve the right to refuse entry to those who fail to comply.)**

1. Disembark from bus **ONLY** when instructed by visitors services personnel.
2. Chaperones/teachers **MUST** remain with their students/children **at all times**. No student will be admitted into any venue without an accompanying chaperone.
3. Our chaperone-to-student ratio is **1:7**. Chaperones are responsible for maintaining **orderly and respectful behavior**.
4. **Show courtesy and respect** for other people and the importance of this battlefield.
Specifically:
 - a. **Speak quietly** even in large, open areas.
 - b. **Do not talk during films or presentations**.
 - c. **Running, jumping** and other boisterous behavior is **prohibited**.
 - d. **Do not be a distraction** to other visitors/groups.
 - e. Do not touch or climb upon displays or exhibits. Use interactives only as intended.
 - f. Only chaperones/teachers should select brochures, taking only the number actually needed.
5. **Backpacks are not allowed** in the building; please leave backpacks on the bus.
6. **Food, drinks, and chewing gum are not allowed** in the Cyclorama, Film or Museum.
7. **Flash photography is not allowed** in the Cyclorama, Film or Museum. This has a detrimental effect on the artifacts over time. **Laser points are also prohibited**.

8. Assemble your group at the theater entrance at least **10 minutes prior** to your scheduled show time. **Late arrivals will not be admitted.**

9. Know the breakdown and number in your group and have one chaperone identify your group members at check-in. **Remain together and proceed quietly**, as instructed by the museum personnel.

10. If your group is expected to take notes, be sure they have the proper materials. **Students are not to lean on or use walls and display cabinets as desktops.**

ATTENTION: NEW LOADING AND UNLOADING LANES FOR 2009

To help you with your visit, we have included information to help you **upon arrival**.
Please share this information with tour leaders and bus drivers.

Note: The Gettysburg National Military Park Museum and Visitor Center is located at **1195 Baltimore Pike**.
(Use the Baltimore Street exit off of Route 15.)
After entering off Baltimore Pike, you will arrive at an **intersection**.

For groups visiting April 1 through June 15, 2009, please note the following:

Groups who have scheduled a Licensed Battlefield Guide as their first timed event should **TURN LEFT** at the intersection, into the Bus/RV parking lot. A Visitor Services representative will meet you there and connect you with your Licensed Battlefield Guide. (For your convenience, restrooms and vending machines are located at the bus drivers' lounge in the Bus/RV parking lot.)

However, these groups arriving more than 30 minutes early and wanting to use the extra time to quickly visit the Museum Bookstore and Gift Shop should **TURN RIGHT** at the intersection and follow the **bus drop-off lane** to the front of the building. Your group will unload in front of the group entrance. (Tickets for the Museum, or the Cyclorama, Film and Museum Experience can be purchased at the group entrance.) Please plan to reassemble your group in time to make the 10-minute walk to the Bus/RV parking lot where a Visitor Services representative will connect you with your bus and Licensed Battlefield Guide.

For all other scheduled visits, please note the following:

TURN RIGHT at the intersection and proceed to the **bus drop-off lane**.
A Visitor Services representative will help direct you.

If you are running late, it is very important that you contact our reservation department at **717-339-2124**.
Please note that late arrivals may cause Licensed Battlefield Guide tours, if applicable, to be forfeited,
and we are not able to offer refunds.

BUS DRIVER INSTRUCTIONS

These instructions will be given to each bus driver bringing a group into the facility.

We have put together the following instructions to make your visit convenient:

- Please proceed to the **bus parking lot** after riders have unloaded.
- Please **DO NOT** leave your bus unattended while in the loading/unloading lanes.
- Please do not arrive at the pick-up area until the **entire** group is ready to board. Early arrivals will be directed to the bus parking lot until the group is ready.
- Please have a means to communicate with your group. Vibrating pagers are available if needed.
- Restrooms and a comfort lounge are available at the bus parking lot.
- Free admission to the Cyclorama, Film and Museum Experience is available for you.
- For any additional needs, please see parking attendants.
